DEAR FRIENDS AND COLLEAGUES.

The German Balint Society (Deutsche Balint Gesellschaft -DBG) feels honored to host the IBF Council Meeting in spring 2022 in Germany.

Aachen is an historical town with a Roman history and the place where Charlemagne was crowned in 800 A.D. The beautiful Aachen cathedral became the first building in Germany recognised as a UNESCO world heritage in 1978. Since 1950 the International Charlemagne Prize is awarded annually for the most valuable contribution to European understanding. Today Aachen also is well known as a student city with more than 50,000 international students in a city with 250.000 inhabitants. The RWTH is assigned as a university of excellence.

For the last 25 years the DBG has organised one of its annual Balint conferences in Aachen. The conference venue is a student meeting place located in the old centre of Aachen and surrounded by coffeehouses and restaurants.

As usual for all IBF conferences the various Balint groups will be led in English by experienced international group leaders. As a second track we will offer Balint groups in German. On Friday, after the opening of the conference, Dr. Phillip Herzog will give his talk "Patience and Politics - Establishing Balint Work in Medical Training in Germany". On Friday evening we invite all participants and accompanying persons to come together with a buffet.

The IBF Council meeting is scheduled for Saturday after lunch from 1.30 to 3.30 p.m. (meanwhile the German speaking Balint groups will have another group session). That way all international Balint groups will have four Balint sessions during the conference and the German speaking Balint groups will have five Balint sessions. On Sunday before closing of the conference a large/fishbowl Balint group is open to all conference participants for a mutual Balint case.

As all IBF Balint meetings should provide time for professional/personal exchange and to meet each other, we will have a Conference Social Event after the Council meeting from 3.30 to 10 p.m. in the old centre of Aachen. We will join a guided tour with historic tales from Aachen, we will have a break with coffee and cake in the oldest coffee Aachen shop and we will visit Aachen Cathedral, the town's landmark. In the evening, a gala dinner will be served in the Ratskeller, one of Aachen's finest restaurants, located beneath the town hall.

Please note that the Conference Social Event on Saturday afternoon/evening is not included in the conference fee and needs an additional booking. All accompanying persons are welcome to join the excursion and the gala dinner, but need a booking in advance, too.

The total fee per person for the Conference Social Event, with the guided tour and including the coffee break with cake and the gala dinner is 70 € (drinks are not included).


